



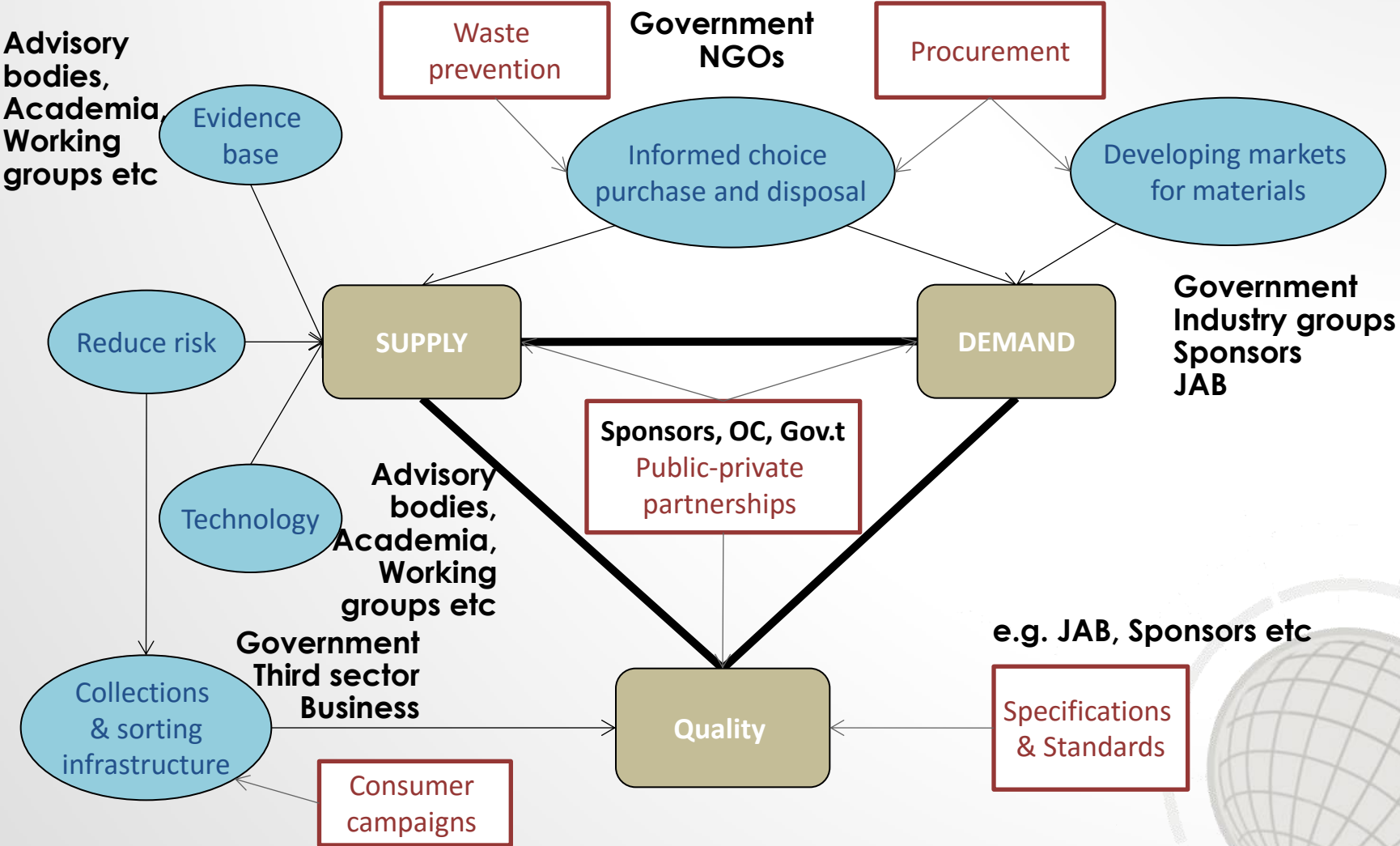

STAKEHOLDER APPROACH

Standards, e.g.

- Requirement - Identify & engage interested parties
- Support – provide additional resource and skills, e.g. training
- Performance evaluation
 - Independent governance
 - Verification - Monitoring, measurement, analysis and evaluation
- Partnership



STAKEHOLDER OPPORTUNITIES

- Business –
 - decoupling consumption from growth SDG
 - low carbon goods & services, e.g. packaging reduction
 - sustainable transport
 - Showcasing local produce and products
 - using the Games to **showcase the economic benefits of sustainability**
 - Meet the (specific) buyer events
- Government –
 - sustainable Tokyo recycling goal (37%)
 - providing **sustainable and accessible transport** solutions
 - independent verification & accountability
- NGOs –
 - **promoting sustainable living** by making sustainability a visible part of the Games
 - education & training e.g. recycling
 - linking communication to national initiatives (consistency)
 - Independent verification
 - dissemination to wider society
- Communities –
 - **legacy contributes to the benefit of** Bayside communities, e.g. inclusion, wellbeing, education, and donation
 - active travel plans
 - legacy projects

ENGAGING EXTERNALLY

- Employment & volunteers
- Educational
- Redevelopment
- Encouraged participation from local businesses e.g. greening the Games
 - 70% of LOCOG suppliers were SMEs
